REQUIREMENTS FOR EXAMINATION/LICENSURE
PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

TEMPORARY LICENSE REQUIREMENTS:

1. Applicants applying for a temporary license are required to pay an initial fee of \$110.00, which covers \$10.00 application fee and \$100.00 temporary fee.
2. Must be at least 18 years of age and a resident of the U.S. Virgin Islands at least 30 days immediately prior to submittal of application.
3. The following documents must be submitted along with the application.
 - a. Three (3) 2x2 recent photographs of applicant.
 - b. Favorable Tax Clearance Letter from the V.I. Bureau of Internal Revenue.
 - c. Letter from V.I. Licensed Real Estate Broker sponsoring applicant.
 - d. Affidavit of residency.

REQUIREMENTS FOR EXAMINATION ONLY:

1. Applicants applying to sit the examination are required to pay the application fee of \$10.00.
2. Must be at least 18 years of age and a resident of the U.S. Virgin Islands at least 30 days immediately prior to submittal of application.
3. The following documents must be submitted along with the application.
 - a. Three (3) 2x2 recent photographs of applicant.
 - b. Favorable Tax Clearance Letter from the V.I. Bureau of Internal Revenue.
 - c. Letter from V.I. Licensed Real Estate Broker sponsoring applicant.
 - d. Affidavit of residency.

PLEASE NOTE:

If you were born in a foreign country, you are required to give the date of naturalization or date when permanent resident status was established. Attach a certified copy of documentation for inspection with this application.

Upon successful completion of the examination, applicants will be required to pay the license fee for permanent licensure. Payments must be made by cash, check or money order. Payments by check or money order must be made payable to the Government of the Virgin Islands.

LAW:

Title 3 V.I.C., Section 423(d) "No person may be licensed as a Real Estate Salesman unless he is (1) at least 18 years of age, (2) a citizen of the United States or a permanent resident alien. No Real Estate Salesman's license may be issued to a partnership, association or corporation. A Real Estate Salesman shall be sponsored by a licensed V.I. Real Estate Broker."

Title 3 V.I.C., Section 424(b) "Reasonable and pertinent information as the Commission may require shall be furnished by the applicant to enable the Commission to determine the honesty, trustworthiness and good moral character of the applicant."

Title 3 V.I.C., Section 301(d) "Any person willfully misrepresenting any fact required to be disclosed in any application shall be liable to penalties for perjury."
